Historical/Biographical Notes

The collection provides a pictorial and written representation of the events held in Lincoln to observe the end of World Wars I and II, Spanish American War, Civil War, as well as the dedication of the Honor Roll. In addition, photographs and documents record the Hartwell Farm fire; the 150th anniversary of the Town of Lincoln; and other observations or special events.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises photographs of Spanish-American War training camp in Peekskill, N.Y., records relating to the welcome home ceremony at the conclusion of World War I, dedication of veterans memorials in 1929 and 1945, records relating to World War II bond drives and rationing, and other records relating to Lincoln's activities relating to wars and veterans. Also included are two sets of photographs of the Hartwell Farm fire in February 1968; programs and ephemera of the 150th anniversary of Lincoln, 1904; photographs and records of minstrel shows presented by St. Anne's-in-the-Fields Episcopal Church, 1930s; clippings, programs, ephemera of various holiday celebrations, 1892-1996; and records of other miscellaneous events or occurrences.
