Historical/Biographical Notes

The collection provides insight into early Lincoln and its families, including family historical and genealogical notes, property and worth of many of the leading citizens, and also provides insight into the development and growth of the town.

Scope and Content

Family records, compiled in part by the Lincoln Historical Society, include family history and genealogical notes, deeds, and other family papers. Estate inventories, a series of photocopies or transcriptions from the Middlesex Probate records were compiled by Elizabeth Little, and include families in Lincoln and the area from the late 17th century through the 18th century. The early Town of Lincoln records provide historical notes on the settlement and incorporation of Lincoln, and provide insight into the early years of the town. Miscellaneous records include other historical notes, including a paper on 'Irish monks', the Hartwell rocker, early pickle industry, and other items.

The collection is organized topically.
