Collection Information

Abstract : The Miscellaneous Journals are an artificial collection of 19th century diaries and account journals kept by three Lincoln residents.

Historical/Biographical Notes

Journals, both account books and diaries are placed in this artificial collection. The account book is unclear as to owner, but appears to be in part accounts of Ogden Codman, although it is attributed to Francis Jones. The diary of Mary Goss, a Lincoln resident and teacher, was begun in 1846 and most entries are of that year. Undated religious writings and poetry follow the diary entries. Miss Goss died in 1849 at the age of 27. The journal of James Lorin Chapin runs from 1848 to 1850. Chapin was born on 1824 and died in 1902. He served as a Lincoln Selectmen, Town Clerk, and in other official capacities.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises primary source materials relating to the Town of Lincoln and the authors of the journals. The collection comprises a diary of Mary W. Goss mostly written in 1846, a journal of James Lorin Chapin, written from 1846 to 1848, with a bound copy. Also included is an account book of uncertain origin, with farm accounts and records of cattle bought and sold from 1862 to 1878.
