Historical/Biographical Notes

Scrapbooks compiled by various Lincoln residents and the Lincoln Public Library between ca. 1850 and 1950, provide insight into social life and customs of the 19th and early 20th century, genealogical information, local history, and information on a variety of topics.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises scrapbooks compiled by various people and the Lincoln Public Library between ca. 1850s and ca. 1950. Content is mixed, and includes local history and genealogy, Lincoln Girl Scouts, the Decordova Museum, social activities and meetings, historical buildings in Lincoln, etc. Most scrapbooks are general in nature and include clippings and photographs of numerous topics.
